

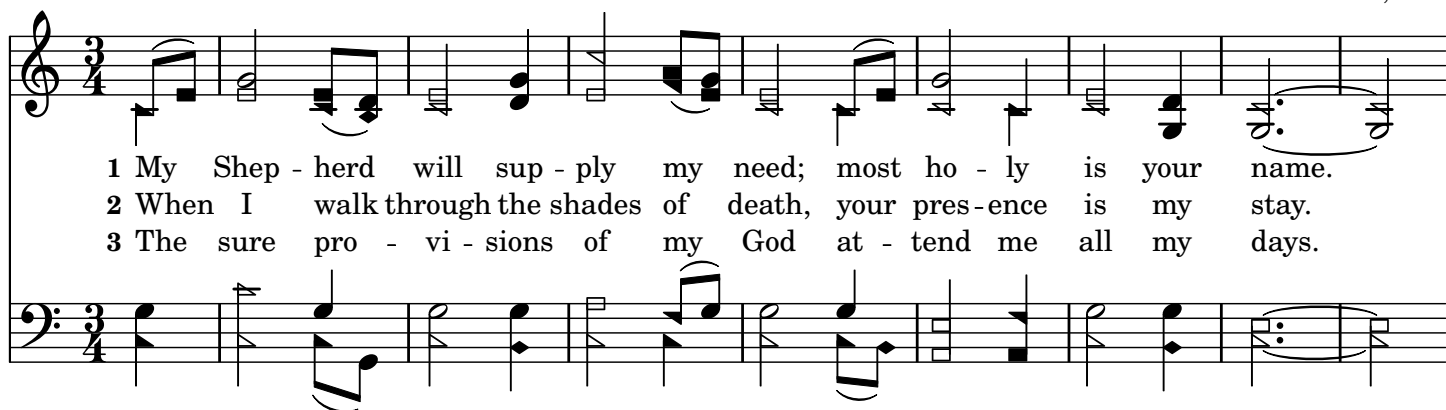

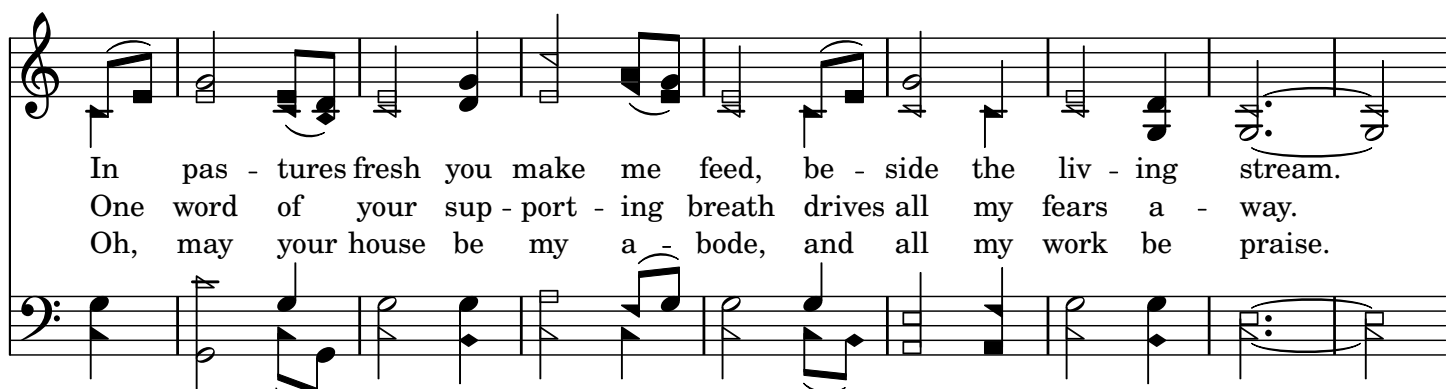

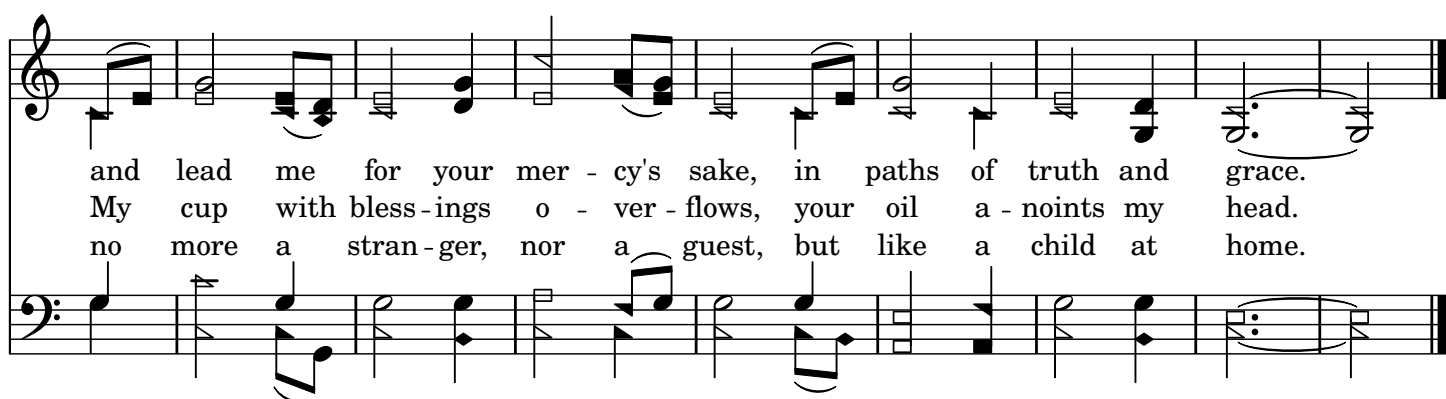
1 My Shep - herd will sup - ply my need; most ho - ly is your name.
