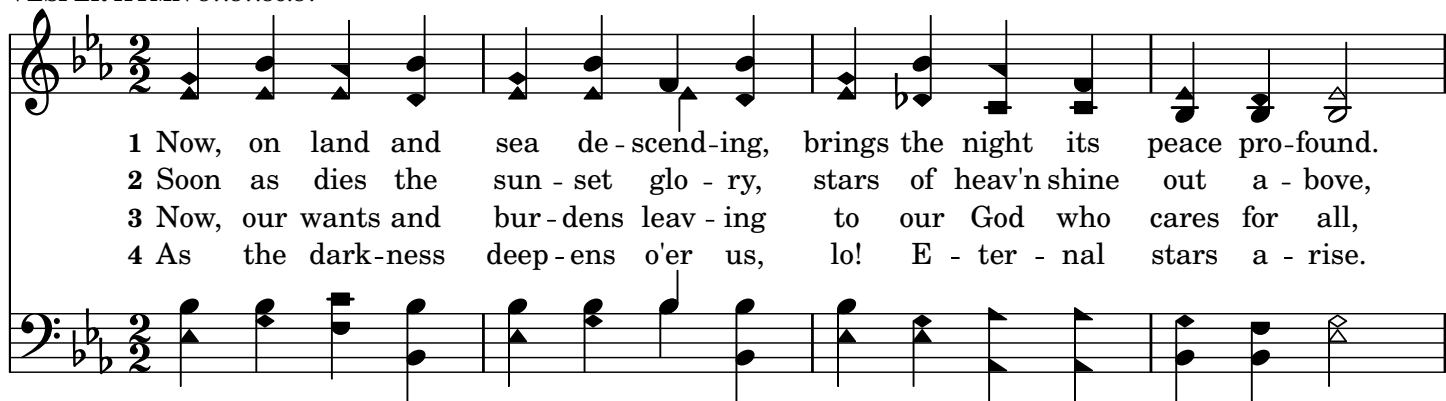

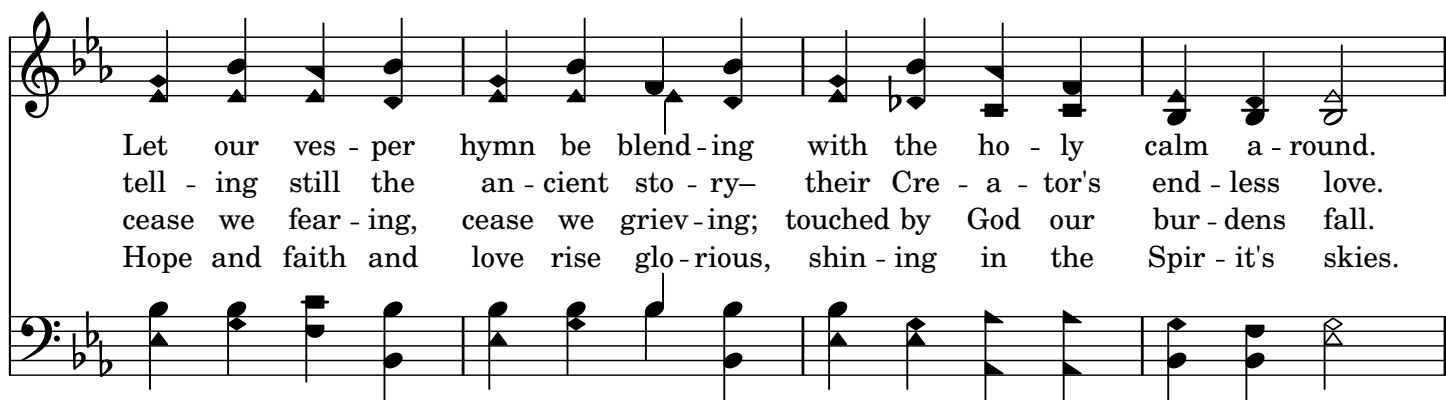

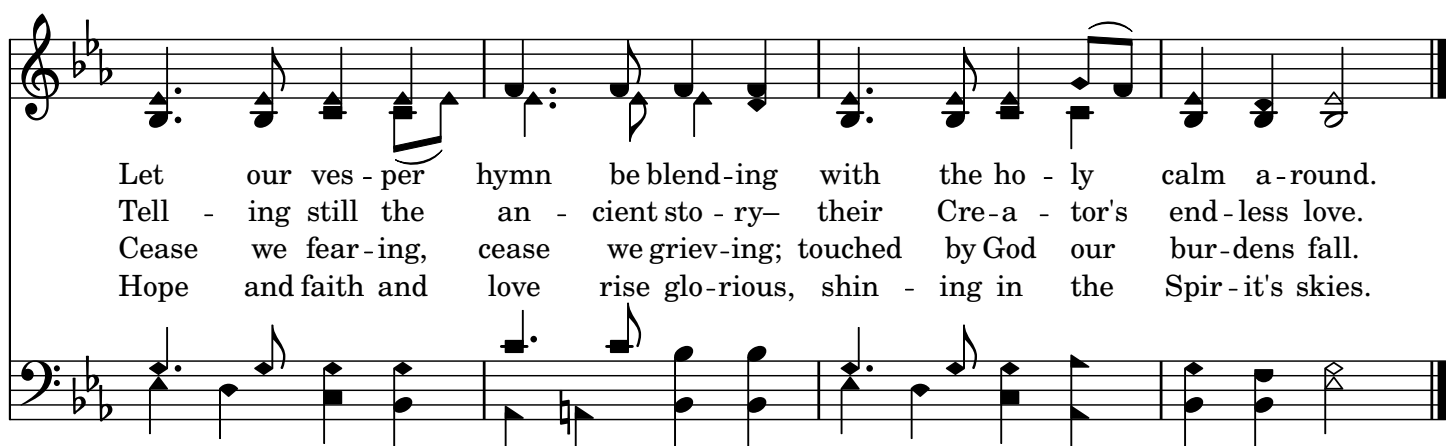
1 Now, on land and sea de - scend - ing, brings the night its peace pro - found.
